Johnson and Johnson Vaccination:

Colby Community College is partnering with the Thomas County Health Department to offer the Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 vaccination on our campus. The Thomas County Health Department will begin administering vaccinations on April 16, 2021, at 10:00 am, vaccinations will be administered in the Fireside Lounge. There is no charge directly to an individual, but they will request your health insurance information. If an individual receives a vaccination, they are required to be monitored for 15 minutes before they are allowed to leave. This is done in an effort to ensure the individual does not have a reaction to the vaccine.
