President Carter presented a policy required to comply with the Code of Federal Regulation so the College is eligible to receive the Congressionally Directed Spending Request.

Donna Henry made a motion to approve the Federal Payment Policy, which Arlen Leiker seconded. It passed 6-0.

## F. IgAlatici - JKB

Trustees review the agreement between Colby Community College and the Kansas Association of School Boards to provide legal assistance at \$2,750 per year (July 1, 2023-June 30, 2024).

Arlen Leiker seconded a motion by Patrick Toth to approve the Legal Assistance Fund. The motion passed 6-0.

## G WHITEHOU

The agreement with the NWKSESC Head Start/Early Start program and Colby Community College provides the Trauma Informed program at a rate of \$50 per credit hour. The annual agreement will be revised before the 2024-25 academic year. The tuition difference is funded through the Workforce Training Funds from the state. Dr. Carter noted the agreement VWUHQJWKHQVreMatkorlsh&pRviDnChelJH¶V Service Center and allows more individuals to access the program. Currently, the USDs receive free training because of Project EVERS (individuals not in K-12 education are not eligible for Project EVERS monies).

A motion by Arlen Leiker was seconded by Donna Henry to approve the agreement with the NWKSESC Head Start/Early Start program and CCC. The motion passed 6-0.


